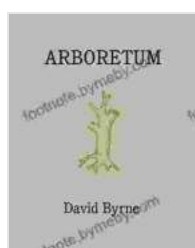


Arboretum: David Byrne's Journey Through Trees

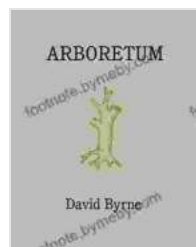
